

WHERE'S WHALEDO?

Discovering hidden details in an artwork is always a joyful and rewarding experience. This hidden picture game will prompt your students to look more closely at art and have fun doing so!

Download the PNG file of Whaledo, our delightful and bespectacled narwhal, and hide him in artworks with the steps below!



- Create a new project. Use custom dimensions
 or select a pre-set design for a document,
 presentation, flyer, or more.
- Upload an artwork reproduction. Drag and drop image files or copy and paste from the web.
- Find a place to hide Whaledo in the artwork.
- Drag and drop the PNG of Whaledo into your project. Resize, rotate, and crop if needed.
- Download the final image as a PNG or JPG. A JPG will generally be a smaller file and is easier to insert into a slide presentation. A PNG is usually a larger file but may look better printed.





Try these tips to help your students get the most out of the game:

- Review using artworks from a previous unit or introduce students to new artworks.
- Label the artworks so students see the artist's name and the artwork title as they search.
- Hide Whaledo near details that might spark a conversation.
- After finding Whaledo, ask students to share other interesting details they noticed in the artwork.
- Make it a race to find Whaledo!
- Print and laminate the images and use dry-erase markers to circle Whaledo.
